



**MEETING NOTES**

**Zoom Virtual Meeting**

Members of the River Commission in attendance included Ryan Davis, Chip Fischer, Erika Gibson, Vice Chairman Scott Schreiber, Joel Shute, and Chris Treese. City Council Liaison Shelley Kaup, Parks Superintendent Dan Roper, Kyle Holt (Roaring Fork Guide Alliance), Commission Staff Liaison Trent Hyatt, Chad Rudow (Roaring Fork Conservancy) and Parks and Recreation Director Brian Smith were also present.

**Receipt of the Minutes from March 3, 2020**

Commissioner Treese provided a motion, seconded by Vice Chairman Schreiber, to approve the minutes from the March 3, 2021 meeting. All were in favor.

**Welcome New Commissioner**

Chairman Moffatt introduced new Commission Chip Fischer to group and thanked him for the service to the City.

**2021 Action Item Assignments**

With the arrival of the new member and the term limited loss of another, Chairman Moffatt led a group discussion of the Commission's action items for the year. Action items were also revised/updated as needed. Each commissioner was assigned, or in some instances re-assigned, specific tasks to be involved in and/or lead throughout the coming year.
