3. Approval of April Minutes
 - a. Jenny Trumble made a motion to approve, Liz Caris second. All in favor, none opposed.
4. Art Plan Draft Review - Josh Lapp
 - a. Front cover artwork options.
 - i. Board likes idea of a piece of art in front of Glenwood landscape.
 - b. Photos of Glenwood's public art throughout the document.
 - c. Direct quotes from survey responses used in Essence Framework sections.
 - d. Bid Ideas Section
 - i. Off the Wall Mural Festival. Outdoor mural festival where artist could be paid a stipend to create their murals. Murals would be displayed around town for a year then sold and fund could be used to fund future stipends.
 - ii. Rio Grand Art Trail. Add art and culture features to trail to connect communities.
 - iii. Art on Top. Art piece that viewers would have to hike to.
 - iv. Jurassic Art. A play on the velociRFTA name with dinosaur themed art encouraging use of public transit. Use of art for wayfinding.
 - v. Natural Playscapes. Installations made with natural objects that are playable.
 - vi. River Art. Art installations in river(s) or at confluences.
 - e. Designed document will be send to board for review and comment.

- i. Board would like to see additional images and content of existed and long-standing public art in Glenwood.
 - ii. Thought to add youth component to document to acknowledge their role in future art.
 - iii. Bilingual translation option. Will work with City for translation of document. Idea to print one document in both languages read front to back or back to front.
 - f. Nest steps
 - i. City staff final review of plan processes and ordinance proposals.
 - ii. At next ACB meeting, have ACB move to have document reviewed and approved by Council.
- 5. Branding and Website Idea
 - a. Much of the information that is wanted on an Arts website exists (GIS map with art location to be added, event calendar capability on Visit Glenwood, Liz's artists directory, etc.). Need to determine where all of the information will be hosted.
 - i. Could live on Visit Glenwood, City site (cogs.us), Parks and Recreation page (glenwoodrec.com), or a subdomain (i.e., glenwoodart.com).
 - ii. Board would prefer a standalone site or a vanity URL for Glenwood Art that serves as artists' resource and public/tourist resource for activities and happenings.
 - 1. City proposed hosting the site on the glenwoodrec.com page to start.
 - 2. Staff will meet internally and with Liz from the Board about site development.
